Formal Grievance Format

This format is to provide detailed information for a grievance in accordance with UCPPE Policy, Policy 7, Section 3, Complaints and Grievances and should only be seen as a suggestive format. In order for the Board of Advisors to make a determination of filed grievance, the complaint must contain enough information in order to do so. There is no specific format for filing a grievance or complaint, however following the below information should assist in providing enough details for a fair decision.

WHAT – You want to explain what the issue is. What is the topic of discussion.

WHERE – Location of where this took place.

WHEN – What date did this incident take place. What **TIME** or round about time.

WHO – Who is the grievance or complaint against. Who all were involved. Who are all witness, if any.

WHY – Why do you believe this took place, and why do you want the board to get involved.

HOW – How did or does this impact you. How does this affect the organization and/or community.

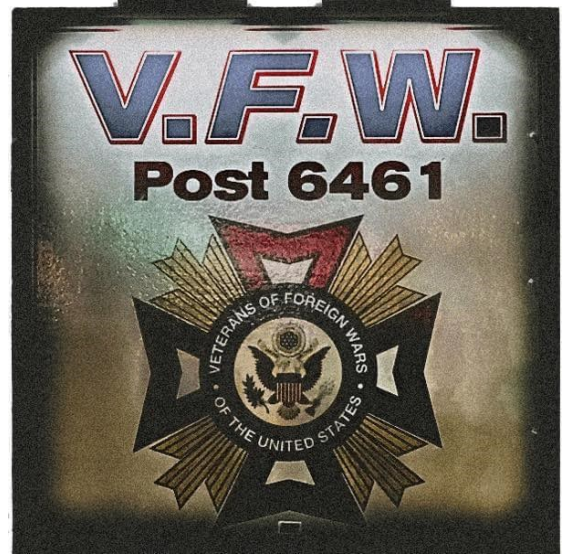
In this letter, you want to explain why something should be done with the individual(s). How this affects you and your ability to perform your role and/or duties. You want to provide as much or many facts as possible and not by hearsay or what you think. We need to know what you know for a fact. Again, this is only a suggestive method in order for the board to be able to act quickly and with enough details to base their decision on facts and fairness.
